Session 2023-24

Academic:

All the students from class Nursery to VIII have got passed in this session and promoted to the next classes respectively.

Grade-wise analysis:

18% students- Grade A (More than 90%)

34% students- Grade B (Between 90- 80%)

19% students- Grade C (Between 80- 70%)

29% students- Grade D (Below 70%)

The result was appreciable in all the classes and subjects. The students were regularly taken to the laboratories (Science, Mathematics and Computer) to comprehend the subjects with practical.

Motile faculties could yield good results by class-wise oral drill.

1 student could achieve 2nd position at State Level Abacus and was awarded by the District Collector on 26 January 2024.

Faculties:

All the faculties appointed are well qualified both academically and professionally. The institute is trying to give them good pay scale to satisfy their need to make them stay longer with the institute.

Total appointed teachers in the session were 34 including 6 NTTs, 17 PRTs, 6 TGTs and 2 PTI.
